

# Marie Murphy School students celebrate art in a big way

For the second straight year, Marie Murphy School is being recognized as the top ranking school in the nation by Celebrating Art for having the most pieces of student artwork selected to be featured in the Celebrating Art book.

One-hundred pieces of student artwork were submitted and 88 were selected for the publication. Marie Murphy art teacher, Kelly Sabtini, submitted all of the student artwork that was accepted in the New Trier Sender School Art Show, which takes place in the spring. Marie Murphy students entered drawings, paintings and ceramic pieces.

The Celebrating Art contest is free to enter, the top 25 percent of the entries are selected for

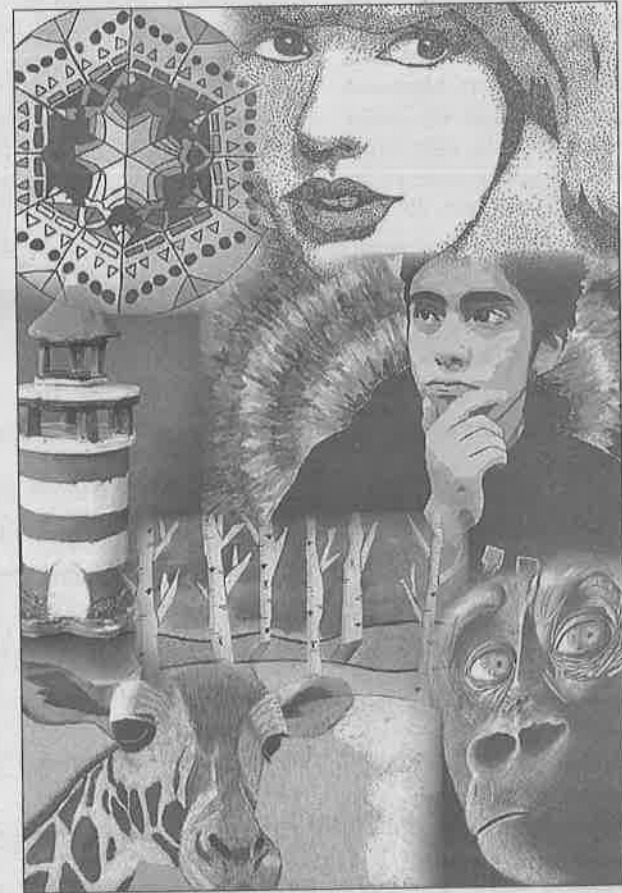
