BOARD OF EDUCATION LEGACY 2015 – 2017

Every odd numbered year the Avoca community typically elects three or four community members to serve on the Board of Education (BOE). That unique Board will stay intact for two full calendar years barring any unforeseen circumstances.

Early in each new cycle the Avoca Board of Education and the Superintendent meet together with a facilitator from the Illinois State Board of Education to generate a legacy document representing the values and priorities of the seven BOE members and the Superintendent.

The eight statements listed below represent the legacy that the 2015-2017 Avoca Board of Education aims to accomplish during their tenure.

- Ensure greater focus on the whole child including social/emotional, leadership and problem-solving skills
- Strive to be a lighthouse district in technology
- Communicate clearly, regularly and effectively with all stakeholders with increased emphasis on the community at-large
- Maintain fiscally responsible spending practices
- Focus on strong academic growth
- Bring facilities to a higher level of safety and efficiency while working within our means
- Value continuous improvement and remain open to new ideas and practices
- Prepare students for future personal success – defined by their own terms
