

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given to Contractors that Avoca School District 37 will be receiving sealed bids for a Roof Replacement at Marie Murphy School. Specifications may be requested from John McCafferty of Tremco, Inc. at (847) 509-1532, between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:30 P.M., Monday through Friday. Specifications will be delivered via email in acrobat pdf format.

Each bid must be placed in a sealed envelope marked "**Sealed Bid: Roof Replacement**" and addressed to Avoca School District 37, 2921 Illinois Road., Wilmette, IL 60091, **Attention: Chief School Business Official. Bids will be received until 1:00 P.M. on the 6th day of March, 2017, at which time the bid opening will take place in the Marie Murphy Room 135.**

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 A.M., Friday, February 24th, 2017, at 2921 Illinois Road, Wilmette, IL. The meeting will begin in the Marie Murphy Room 135. This will be the only opportunity to tour the roof. It is the responsibility of the Bidder/Contractor to attend and sign-in at the pre-bid conference. Failure to attend and sign-in at the pre-bid conference shall result in the rejection of any bids submitted by those non-attending Contractors.

Bid security in the form of a bid bond, certified check or cashier's check in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the base bid shall be submitted with the bid. Performance, Labor and Material Payment Bonds and Certificate of Insurance will be required from the successful Bidder.

The Board of Education, Avoca School District 37, Wilmette, Illinois, reserves the right to waive all technicalities, to accept or reject any or all bids, to accept only portions of a proposal and reject the remainder. Bids shall not include federal excise tax or state sales tax. An Exemption Certificate will be furnished by the district on request of the bidder.

The Work of this Project is subject to the Illinois *Prevailing Wage Act*, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 *et seq.* A prevailing wage determination has been made by the District, which is the same as that determined by the Illinois Department of Labor for public works projects in Cook County. The contract entered into for the Work will be drawn in compliance with said law and proposals should be prepared accordingly and provide for payment of all laborers, workmen, and mechanics needed to perform the Work at no less than the prevailing rate of wages (or the prevailing rate for legal holiday and overtime work) for each craft, type of worker, or mechanic.

The contractor(s) selected will also be required to comply with all federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and executive orders pertaining to equal employment opportunity.
